

The preparedness plan and measures Riverdale Church is taking to ensure our Riverdale Kids environments, are providing a safe and impactful experience for those attending our in-person gatherings.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each classroom will be limited to 50% occupancy.
 - Once 50% capacity is reached, children will be invited to attend the main service with their family.
 - Classrooms and toys will be sanitized in-between services.
 - Check in stations will be sanitized in-between services.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available at all check in stations and in all classrooms.
 - Families (when possible) will be asked to only have one adult enter the Riverdale Kids area for drop off and pick up.
 - We will continue to release a Riverdale Kids Online Experience on the Riverdale Kids Facebook page each weekend.
 - We cannot accept any child into our Riverdale Kids Rooms with a runny nose, cough or fever, we ask that you enjoy the service online from home.
 - Each child (Nursery-Elementary) will need a printed name tag to enter the Kids Area
- Riverdale Kids Rooms will open 10 min. before service begins.**
Child sized masks are available at the Kids Welcome desk.

VOLUNTEERS

- Volunteers will be required to wear a mask. Single use masks will be available.

CHECK IN

- Check in stations will be sanitized in-between services.
- All stations will be self-service.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at each check in station.

CLASSROOMS

- Each classroom will be limited to 50% occupancy.
- Outside toys and snacks will temporarily not be permitted in the classrooms.
- If pacifiers and bottles are brought, we are asking that parents label them with the child's name.
- Families will be asked to only have one adult (when possible) enter the Riverdale Kids area for drop off and pick up. The same parent will drop off and pick up from the classrooms.
- Hand sanitizer and gloves will be available in all classrooms.
- Classrooms and toys will be sanitized in-between services.
- Cleaning checklist includes: toys, surfaces, diaper changing areas, door handles, bathrooms and furniture.
